GEN. KUROPATKIN SENT TO PETROGRAD UNDER GUARD

Was Chief in Command of Russian Forces in Manchuria During Russo-Japanese War... Tashkent, Russian Turkestan, via London, April 23, 11:10 p. m.—General Alexei Kuropatkin, former governor-general of Turkestan, who was arrested recently on a charge of distributing arms to Russians for defense against natives in the event of an attack, has been sent to Petrograd under guard.
