PATROTIC RALLY

Judge Edward K. Nicholas, of Bridgeport, Principal Speaker - Rev. Joseph H. Selden, General William A. Aiken and A. A. Browning Addressed the Gathering.

In spite of the disagreeable weather, about 100 to 125 people braved the storm and attended the patriotic rally held in the town hall, Friday evening when Judge Edward K. Nicholas of Bridgeport, the principal speaker, gave a stirring address.

Joseph T. Fanning presided at the meeting and the reading of a proclamation issued by President Wilson and the one issued by Secretary of War Baker regarding recruiting. He referred to the fact that Norwich's quota of enlistments in the regular army is 50.

Mr. Fanning introduced as the first speaker Judge Edward K. Nicholas of Bridgeport, who in part said: It is a matter of satisfaction to me to see that so many people who are not afraid of the rain and I want to congratulate you in showing that you are awake to the fact that there is a war in existence. NEW HAVEN ROAD SEEKS FURTHER ECONOMIES

Too Many Freight Cars Are Tied Up Now. Not only will the New York, New Haven & Hartford railroad attain certain economies and improvement in operating conditions through the elimination of some 200 passenger trains on June 26, but it is seeking similar results through rearrangement of freight trains, says the Boston News Bureau.

Freight service to some points is being curtailed and to others increased, and in many instances freight trains are being consolidated, giving some small localities only one freight a day where formerly they had two.

The railroads are striving in the direction of heavier loading in order to conserve supply of freight cars. They are seeking to move only full cars and not half empty cars. The railroads war board has recommended that cars be loaded 10 per cent in excess of marked capacity.

The New Haven seeks to obtain comprehensive embargoes in effect on many classes of freight from connecting lines, with the exception of freight cars owned or for use of the United States government, its allies or the American Red Cross society. Perishable fields and livestock, foodstuffs, copper, smelter, zinc, crucibles, nursery stock, and other essential materials and products will be accepted only when cars are loaded to the maximum practical carrying capacity of the car.

The New Haven lines are still much congested with freight cars. A week ago there were 11,829 freight cars standing on sidetracks waiting to be unloaded, a figure regarded as a record. While there was an improvement shown a few weeks ago, the number of cars waiting recently has been on the increase. At the worst of the congestion in the winter when cars were adding their quota of interference with traffic, the number of cars waiting to be unloaded did not get much above 13,000 on the system.
