Canetown, April 28.—A report issued by the official Custodian of Enemy Property in South Africa shows that 26,600 enemy stockholders controlled nearly \$40,000,000 worth of stock in South Africa mining companies. The Custodian has taken charge of all this stock, together with other enemy property, such as farms and business and trading concerns.

The work of liquidation has been enormous, but it is now asserted that "there is not a single firm in South Africa carrying on business wholly or chiefly in the interests of enemy persons."

The British Workers' League has sent a telegram of greeting to General Foch on his new appointment, assuring him of the "complete confidence of the British democracy in this supreme crisis of the war."
