MAY SHIFT HIGH TENSION WIRES Possibility of Bringing Transmission Line From Eastern Power Company Up West Side of Thames River to Kiteaug—May Cross River at This Point—Kiteaug Property Purchased.

The purchase of the property at Kiteaug owned by William E. Walker, president of the American Thermos Bottle Company, by the Eastern Connecticut Power Company brings to light the fact that there may be a possibility of the high tension line from the company's plant at Montville running up the west side of the Thames river and crossing the river at this point rather than to cross the river directly from the company's plant.

The land which has been purchased by the power company includes 75 acres of land on which the present Camp Dewey is situated.
