Change of reference was made at request of labor committee on the bill concerning certificates of employment of children, and it went to the committee on education. The act concerning cooperative insurance was sent from the labor to the insurance committee.

Unfavorable reports came from the judiciary committee, relating to prohibition officers' bills, and the bills were rejected. The subject matters are covered in other bills that will be favorably reported.

Announcement was made that there will be public hearing next Tuesday at 2 o'clock, on the Morrison school bill so-called.

The judiciary committee will give hearing, Thursday, Feb. 27, in the hall of the house of representatives on the workmen's compensation act.

Business of the senate, acted upon by that body last Thursday was received in the house and tabled for calendar.

THE SENATE. The committee on the judiciary reported unfavorably on the bill to require a license for animal drawn vehicles on the highway. The bill was rejected.

The humane institutions committee have hearings Tuesday afternoon on the acts making an appropriation for a new dormitory at Mystic Oral School for the Deaf. Hearings were also given on an act changing the name of the Norwich State Hospital for the Insane, to make it Norwich State Hospital; and another bill which had taken a new building for the same institution.

The judiciary committee passed an approved all minor court judgments set for hearing Tuesday afternoon, that were uncontested. There were many of them, including those for Williamstown, Killingly, Stafford, Springs, Rockville, Stonington, Norwich, Griswold. Consideration was also given on an act creating a New London city ordinance in regard to salaries of town officials; and an act concerning the borough court of Groton. This act provides for a division of cases collected in the town court between the borough and the town.
