Sprinkling Notice

TO PROPERTY OWNERS AND TENANTS Any person who obtained a written permit from the Board of Water Commissioners to use city water for sprinkling purposes during the season of 1918, can use the water at the same rate during the 1919 season, without obtaining a permit, and unless notice to the contrary is received at the Board of Water Commissioners' Office on or before July 15, 1919, it will be taken for granted that it is used. All others intending to use water for sprinkling purposes, tenants included, must obtain a written permit. The sprinkling season is from April 1st to September 30th.
