FORECAST OF RED CROSS PEACE WORK

With a membership of 5,629 this year which compared with 5,732 in the year before and the hoped for goal of 10,000 members for the coming year, the Norwich chapter of the Red Cross held its annual meeting Wednesday afternoon at 4 o'clock in the Elks' hall.

Secretary's Report. Miss Edith E. Young, secretary, gave her annual report as follows, covering from November, 1918, to October, 1919: The year that has passed since the last annual meeting of the Norwich Chapter has been a time of readjustment for in the very early days of the year we were faced with the problem of transition from war to peace.

On behalf of the Norwich Chapter, I speak with appreciation of the invaluable assistance that has been rendered by the local press. Both The Bulletin and The Record have co-operated most generously with us to put before the public Red Cross ideals and Red Cross information.

Department reports were next taken up. Miss Young read the report of Mrs. Addie M. Preston on nursing service in which she spoke of the two Red Cross courses, one under Mrs. W. K. Thucley, R. N., and the other under Miss Charlotte Albertine, R. N., for which the Red Cross hospital was furnishing much equipment.

On chapter production, Miss Young read the report of Miss Matilda Butta, which spoke of meeting the quota of 200 Red Cross garments from April to June, work in knitting, and answering the call for household linen.
