FINANCIAL AND COMMERCIAL

Market Was Reactionary New York, Aug. 24.—Increased weakness of foreign exchange and further detachment of public interest accounted chiefly for the reactionary trend of today's stock market.

Rates of remittances continued to move against London, Paris and other important foreign centers, although the day's advances dealing with European affairs should have been helpful to international credit conditions.

Quotations on London fell almost 10 cents under their recent maximum and francs broke sharply. Further depreciation of sterling was again attributed to offerings of grain bills by our exporters.

Buying of rails, which assumed relative large dimensions, was said to have emanated from substantial sources, who are supposed to favor those properties because of the recent rate advances.

Bonds of reorganized railroads, especially convertible issues, were strong, generally 1 to 2 points above issues and international continued irregular. Total sales (par value) aggregated \$5,500,000.
