Atlantic City, May 18.—Jack Dempsey, heavyweight champion who is at this place preparing to defend his title against Georges Carpentier at Jersey city on July 2, is doing a little more work each day. The experts say he will be ready to meet his rugged opponent on Saturday, when his daily workouts are scheduled to begin.


