IN NORWICH FIFTY YEARS AGO

With the exception of a fire on what was known as Mill Pond Lane, little out of the ordinary occurred in Norwich fifty years ago this week.

Just a half century ago the officers of the old Third Regiment met in New London and selected a uniform to be worn by the men of the regiment.

Wednesday, November 1, 1871—A meeting of the officers of the Third Regiment, C. N. G., will be held at the armory of Company D in New London this afternoon for the purpose of choosing a uniform and transacting other business.

Monday, October 30, 1871—The Minnetonka Fire company of Danversville reached this city on the 9:30 train Saturday morning.

Thursday, November 2, 1871—The first meeting of the commissioned officers of the Third Regiment, C. N. G., under Col. Ames, was held at the Metropolitan hotel, New London, Wednesday afternoon for the purpose of selecting a uniform for the corps.

Friday, November 3, 1871—Sawford A. Chapman has purchased the lot adjoining the market of C. J. Winters on West Main street for \$4,000 and it is understood will erect a large brick building there.

A fire broke out in the upper-room of the mammoth cotton mill of A. & W. Sprague at Baltic yesterday afternoon about 1 o'clock.

Wednesday, November 4, 1871—Bluefish have struck out and no more are expected in market this season.

Ernest Cady of Stafford has purchased the store and business of the Norwich Woolen Company at Bean Hill.

At about 11:15 last night a fire was discovered in a small barn on Mill Pond Lane, in the rear of the residence of H. C. Hill.

Almost before the first alarm was sounded the building was wrapped in a sheet of flame and before the first stroke of the fire bell it was past redemption.
