TOTAL TAX, NORMAL AND SUB-TAX

TABLE PREPARED BY TREASURY EXPERTS. Washington, Nov. 8.—(By The A. P.)—The total tax, normal and sub-tax, which would be paid on given incomes under the senate bill as compared with the present law, based on the net income of a married person without dependents, is shown in the appended table, prepared by treasury experts.

The normal tax under the senate bill would be the same as that under the present law.

Under the bill as it passed the house the tax on an income of \$100,000 would have been \$28,470; \$200,000, \$68,470; \$300,000, \$108,470; \$500,000, \$188,470; \$1,000,000, \$388,470; \$2,000,000, \$788,470; \$3,000,000, \$1,188,470; and \$5,000,000, \$1,988,470.
