CAUSED THE FALL OF THE PEKING CABINET

New York, Dec. 19.—Efforts of Chang Tsoo Lin, high commissioner of Manchuria, brought about the fall of the Peking cabinet according to a statement today by Robert Harris, of the China News Bureau, the publicity organization in America of Sun Yat Sen's National government. General Chang, he said, went to Peking last week during the progress of direct negotiations with Japan at the Washington conference. It was announced that his visit was to obtain money for the support of troops. This was significant, Mr. Harris said, because of the reasons given for the resignation of the cabinet was its inability to deal with the financial situation. General Chang, he declared, is said to be planning to succeed Hsu Shih Chang as president of China and, according to Mr. Harris, this is the first move toward that end.
