and dry thoroughly. Never dry near the fire as too much heat will crack the wood. Tumbler which have contained milk should be first rinsed in cold water before washing in hot water. Thoroughly scald daily all vessels used for milk.

There are one of the most useful and satisfactory helps in laundry work. To bleach white garments, use one tablespoon of borax in one gallon of water. Wash the clothes dry in the sun, and repeat the process if necessary. To wash colored ribbons, make a strong lather of cold water and fine soap. Wash the ribbons in this lather several times, always in soapy water, then several times in plain water. When partly dry, iron these pieces of muslin, having the ribbons perfectly smooth.
