

# DEVELOPMENTS RECORDED

## Work Recounted in Annual Report of Secretary Fall—Tells of Discovery of New Oil Fields, Increasing Production of Oil and Its Products, Exploitation of Coal Deposits, and the Opening of Mines in the Western States—More Than 130,000 Pension Claims Disposed of—Applications for Patents Numbered in Excess of 113,500—Contribution to National Stabilization and Prosperity.

Washington, Dec. 5.—The development of the country's natural resources under the control of the interior department has contributed in great measure to national stabilization and prosperity. Secretary Fall declared today in his annual report. The secretary listed the more outstanding of these contributions as opportunities for home making upon public lands, the exploitation of coal and other minerals, the discovery of new oil fields, development of existing fields and increasing production of oil and its products, the opening of mines in the western states, and the opening of mines in the western states.

Incidentally, the interior secretary declared these developments have resulted in very substantial cash returns to the federal treasury and to the various states in which these mineral resources have been developed under leading laws.

### Land Office and Pension Office

The outstanding administrative accomplishment of the department during the fiscal year ended June 30, 1922, was declared to be the reaching of almost of current work in both the land office and the pension office. The land office has in the former office, a situation which has not existed for many years, the secretary said. This, he added, has already resulted in the placing in the hands of people assets valued at more than \$20,000,000 and has been done without increase in force of the office and in the face of greatly increasing work.

### Reclamation of Arid Lands

Wider extension of the reclamation policy in former arid lands of the West was recommended in the report, which showed that while funds were restricted for the year, the extension of the reclamation service justified the continuation of the reclamation policy. On new irrigation projects was started despite the lack of funds and the total value of the work, based on reclaimed lands was estimated at more than \$47,000,000. The benefits in the way of making homes, increasing food production and adding to the national wealth by the reclamation of lands make that work of great value in return to prosperity, the report said.

### Education of Indians

Education of Indians, which falls to the lot of the interior department, has been greatly promoted during the year. The number of pupils in the schools was 1,390, greater than in any previous year. A special effort to provide greater health facilities to the Indians through more hospitals and more extensive nursing service was made.

### 130,000 Pension Claims

More than 130,000 pension claims were disposed of during the year by the bureau of pensions and social security. Claims for pensions, the accumulation in March, 1921, were handled, practically all number of claims of the rolls at the end of the fiscal year was 547,016, being 19,327 less than the previous year. The amount disbursed for pensions was \$153,397,441. The report said that this service was attained by the decrease in the cost of adjudication and payment.

### 115,000 Applications for Patents

A record-breaking number of applications for patents in this country was received by the patent office, more than 115,000. This has caused great need of increased office space and the interior department has been planning for the past three years, the director reported. It may be necessary further to augment the number of employees. The patent office is a self-supporting institution, Mr. Fall pointed out adding that last year the receipts of the office were \$173,000 greater than the previous year.

### National Parks

The playgrounds of the nation, its national parks and monuments, were visited by a record-breaking number of persons. More than 1,316,000 citizens of every state and territory in the nation's possessions and many foreign countries viewed the wonders of nature preserved in these parks.

### Evolution for Storage of Oil

Evolution for storage of oil drawn from government oil wells in the west, to allow for keeping greater quantities of crude oil, was recommended by the secretary. He said that the government, which is forced to sell its oil royalties monthly, may take advantage of better markets by storing its oil. The secretary pointed out that the storage of oil is absolutely necessary, it was said, under the present system. The storage of oil in periods of depression to the injury of the consumer. To the extent that the government is able to store oil in business, it should through its influence toward stabilization rather than toward demoralization of the industry, he said.

### Royalties from Oil Land Leases

Pointing out the government takes its royalties from oil land leases in the form of crude oil, Mr. Fall said that returns from this source during the year amounted to \$22,480,000, while in the fiscal year 1921, \$22,480,000 was received by the Indian tribes from royalties on oil produced from Indian owned lands.

### Alaska and Hawaii

Reports of the governors of Alaska and Hawaii, summarized in the interior report, review the progress of the two territories during the year. Governor Bone, of Alaska, noted that a steady increase in exports and imports has developed returning prosperity and said that with encouragement a strong tide of immigration might have set in. He added that, however, until some time ago, the population of Alaska and industries started the population could not be expected to increase greatly. ## PHILLIPS KNOWS NOTHING OF WIFE'S ESCAPE FROM PRISON

Los Angeles, Dec. 5.—Arthur L. Phillips, whose wife, Clara Phillips, convicted murderer, escaped from the Los Angeles county jail last night, appeared at the office of her attorney late today and sent word to the sheriff's office that he was ready to be interviewed about the escape.

Phillips later made a statement in which he said he knew nothing about the escape or where his wife had gone. He gave a detailed account of his movements for the past 24 hours.

In his statement Phillips said he received the first inkling of Mrs. Phillips' escape through the papers. His first move upon learning of the jail break, he said, was to telephone to her attorney, Herrington, and she continued the conference which resulted several hours later in a message "ready to tell what he knew about the escape."

Mrs. Clara Phillips was under sentence of imprisonment for ten years in the state penitentiary for the murder of Mrs. Alberta Meadows. Her escape was so well planned and executed that it remained unknown for more than six hours.

Three steel bars guarding the window in her cell were sawed through from the inside by means of heavy shears. The opening thus formed the woman made her way and over adjacent roofs of other cells she slipped down through a trap-door and out to where liberty and an automobile awaited her.

The sheriff detached deputies to all parts of the portion of the city on the boundary of Mexico. He also had all depots and the main roads out of north Los Angeles thoroughly searched. Descriptions of the woman and her husband were given to nearby police officers and personally led a search of those places to which she was believed the woman might have fled.

Investigation indicated that at least three persons had aided the woman. The sheriff's office is conducting a search of the city. There are already jailers and matrons on duty and a glare of search lamps surrounds it.

The matron on duty at the time of the escape was Mrs. I. D. Fisher, long a member of the jail staff. She said she saw Mrs. Phillips in her cell at about 2:30 last night, when she was complaining of illness. Mrs. Fisher said she then returned to the matron's quarters and saw Mrs. Fisher's door open. Mrs. Fisher said she heard nothing unusual.

Mrs. Fisher said she knocked on all doors to see if any were open. Later she called the warden and when Mrs. Fisher noticed that Mrs. Phillips had not appeared she asked other prisoners concerning her and they said she was "around here some place." Still unable to locate her, the matron resumed her routine work and then she called the warden and reported the missing of Mrs. Phillips told her.

# Erm to Become a British Protect Dominion Today

## All Formalities Have Been Concluded for the Inauguration Ceremonies.

Dublin, Dec. 5. (By the A. P.)—With the announcement from London that the royal assent has been given to the Irish constitution and that Timothy Healy had been appointed governor-general, all formalities have been concluded for the inauguration of the Free State government. The Dail Eireann meets as the Free State parliament tomorrow night to elect a speaker, swear in the members and proceed with the election of a senate.

Mr. Healy will be sworn in as governor tomorrow by the lord chief justice. In his residence at Chapelwell in the outskirts of Dublin, the new governor general said tonight that his position was that he was representative of the imperial government and had no voice in the management of the country. He said that the constitution was not violated, and on the other hand, that the treaty was adhered to.

At the inauguration ceremony, the British troops took possession of the customs house in Constantinople. # "PLOGS" IN CONGRESS WOULD CHANGE ELECTION LAWS

## Pressure of Proposal May Test the Power of the New "Bloc"—Will Encounter Opposition From President Harding and Administration Leaders in the Senate—Aim to Abolish Electoral College and Have President and Vice President Elected by Popular Vote—Such Method Would Make Possible the Election of a President and Vice President From Different Parties—Constitutional Amendment Has Been Favorably Reported by the Senate Agricultural Committee.

Washington, Dec. 5. (By the A. P.)—The president probably would deliver his message on the state of the union Thursday or Friday. Officials did not indicate the cause of the delay, although it was understood that the executive, having submitted the bill to the senate, was waiting for the senate to act. The bill was being carefully studied by the senate and house in joint session.

Pressure of public business was believed to be in part responsible for the delay, but there were also intimations that the president's message would be a declaration of the state of the union. The executive also discussed the immigration question at length with his cabinet today and it was indicated that he might submit a bill to the senate on the subject of the standpoint of restriction. The shipping bill and annual appropriation measures are already lined for disposal at the present session.

### STOCK DIVIDENDS OF \$21,000,000 MADE BY SEVEN CONCERNS

New York, Dec. 5.—Stock dividends totaling \$21,000,000 were announced today by seven large industrial corporations and banks, bringing the total stock dividends declared in the last four months to \$20,000,000. These sums in virtually all cases have been approved for out-of-distribution surplus, apparently in anticipation of a possible tax legislation in the next congress.

The Standard Oil corporation increased its capitalization \$10,000,000 by declaring a 100 per cent stock dividend. The Vacuum Oil company declared \$4,000,000 of surplus in the form of a 200 per cent stock dividend. The Williams-Wright-Jones company declared \$1,000,000 of surplus in the form of a 100 per cent stock dividend. The Equitable Trust company announced plans to increase its capital from \$12,000,000 to \$20,000,000, which would be a 33 1/3 per cent stock dividend and the remainder a new issue of stock to which holders of the bank stock would subscribe.

The E. I. Dupont de Nemours company declared a 50 per cent stock dividend totaling \$2,000,000. The Whitman Mills company, New Bedford, called a stockholders' meeting to consider a stock dividend of 50 per cent by increasing its capitalization from \$2,000,000 to \$3,000,000.
