The permanent improvement of the Potomac river at the head of tide-water, suggested, contemplates opening a new channel along the neck of land leading to Observatory Hill. This involves an outlay for—

3d. Transfer of Observatory to Meridian Hill, or some other suitable location.
4th. Transfer (if desired) of the city canal from Observatory Hill to the city margin of the new channel.

- 5th. Health for the West End of Washington.
6th. Revenue from increase in value of property along the aqueduct.
7th. Health for the West End of Washington.
8th. Revenue from increase in value of property along the aqueduct.

In the annexed plan, W is Washington, G is Georgetown, A is Alexandria, I is the island which would be formed by Clinton's proposed "cut" for the channel of the river to pass along the wharves of the city.
