The Pennsylvania Liquor Law.

The prohibitory law of Pennsylvania provides that no unlicensed persons shall sell or keep for sale intoxicating liquors of any kind, under penalty and a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for the first offense and imprisonment not exceeding one month, and for a second offense a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars and imprisonment not exceeding three months.
