Yesterdays morning east of Summit 400 feet of sheds were crushed by a snow-slide, burying the track several feet deep.

A force of men were sent from Truckee to clear away the mass. The snow fell steadily all day.

The weather was so clear that the entire road would be clear by this morning, with the exception of the place east of Yolo, where the slide occurred.

If these slides were realized, the east and west-bound trains will approach that point to-day, and passengers and mail will be transferred.

A cargo train was put to work yesterday to clear away the fallen debris of the landslide by means of ground-blows. The track may possibly be cleared and trains running through in two days.

The lightning train makes regular trips between Sacramento and Alameda. Trains were running on the Oregon and Sacramento washout at Bear river rendering transfers impossible.

The early morning fog will continue until the water leaves at 4:30. No passengers are to go out on that route.
