LOCAL INTELLIGENCE.

BOARD OF CITY TRUSTEES.

The Board of City Trustees met yesterday with all the members present.

John A. Cunningham, Chief Engineer of the Water Works, reported that the number of gallons of water pumped last week was 7,320,750, and 907 cubic feet of gas coke was consumed.

The petition of D. E. Alexander to have the taxes for 1873-74 on the north 26 feet of the south half of lot 8, in the block between N and P streets, cancelled, was granted.

Property owners petitioned the Board to delay action in conformity with the order passed at the last meeting directing that certain streets and alleys east of Agricultural Park be opened.

A communication was received from several property-holders asking permission to withdraw their claims for a large amount against J. T. Still being allowed to erect a frame addition to his building between Sixth and Seventh streets.

James Finnegan requested permission to erect a one-story frame building on K street, between Seventh and Eighth, but in view of the fact that C. Schindler and others filed a monument against the same, the matter was laid over for one week.

Proposals for sprinkling District No. 7 were opened, and the contract for the same work was awarded to P. McHale at \$625.

The official bond of L. F. Bassett, as City Surveyor, in the sum of \$20,000, with Leo Stanley and Miles Byrne as sureties, was approved and ordered on file.

On motion of Trustee Johnson, it was ordered that the sum of \$2000 be transferred from the Special Water Works Fund to the Water Works Fund.

The petition of Geo. Hellhorn and others, asking that that portion of the city lying east of Twenty-sixth street and south of N street be excluded from the pond lands, also was granted and ordered on file.

A. J. Hopper, City Expert, reported that he had examined the accounts of Geo. E. District Attorney Blanchard, and that he had overpaid the City the sum of \$1547, which amount the Board ordered him to pay.

SUPERIOR COURT PRACTITIONERS.

In the Superior Court of Sacramento county yesterday the following rule in regard to the admission of candidates to practice in that court was established: "Any person desiring to be admitted to the bar of this court, through any member of the bar, present a certificate signed by two regularly admitted and practicing attorneys of at least two years' practice in the Courts of record of this State, and move the Court to admit such applicant. Such certificate must show that the applicant is of good moral character and integrity, and that the subscribers have fully examined him touching the qualifications of such applicant in point of learning in law, and that in their opinion the applicant possesses the requisite qualifications in all respects to be admitted to practice. Upon the making of such motion, the Court shall appoint, and appointing two members of the bar whose duty it shall be to be present and aid in the examination, which shall be had in open Court. No non-resident of this State will be examined for admission until he shall have been first examined and admitted in the Superior Court of the county of his residence.

NEW ORGANIZATION—CAPITAL GYMNASIUM CLUB.

There have been several efforts to form a gymnastic club in this city, but they have met with small success. A recent effort has made more progress. The demand for an athletic club is greater than ever, and one conducted with any approach to a proper system will succeed. Saturday the Capital Gymnasium Club was organized.
