

DOMESTIC NEWS. Damaging Break in a Levee. QUINCY (Ill.), June 30th. - Three hundred feet of the levee below this city has given away.

IMMENSE LOSS. HANSHAL (Mo.), June 30th. - What is known as the Sny levee, an embankment which protects the Illinois bottom for many miles north and south of Quincy from the overflowing of the Mississippi river, broke at 3 o'clock this morning near Cincinnati Landing.

THE AREA OVERFLOWED. QUINCY (Ill.), June 30th. - The water is now spreading rapidly, and an area several miles in extent is already overflowed.
