Ex-Senator Gwin on the Presidential Canvass.

New York, July 10th.—The Express this evening says: Senator Farley and Dr. Gwin were interviewed at the New York Hotel today, the latter being the subject of an interview by the Republicans. The Chinese question is a vital one on the Pacific coast, and it is not surprising that Gwin should attempt to delude the people by promises from the Republicans of amendment of the Burlingame Treaty and the restriction of Chinese immigration. Gwin's individual record as a legislator will be his best test. The changes made among the Workingmen's Party will give aid to Hancock. We do not expect to have Kearney. He may be useful to the Republicans. The changes on the Greenback note will be in our favor. Mr. Gwin said that the doubtful States in the pending contest were, in his judgment, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Ohio and Wisconsin. The Pacific side of the country, he thought, is strong for Hancock. He said that the new culture in English and French. There has been large immigration into that State, and most of it from Democratic sections. Citizenship is there acquired by show of residence, and the new culture will give Democrats a victory at the ballot-box. Hancock's nomination, he said, was like an inspiration. It aroused the Convention, and the enthusiasm has extended to all sections of the Union. No other name before the Convention could have been put forward with the enthusiasm, and carried with the prestige of popular favor that Hancock's. Indian Territory Intruders.

WASHINGTON, July 10th.—Secretary Schurz says he has issued orders to immediately employ all necessary military force to prevent any occupation of Indian Territory by the Payne expedition, or any similar unlawful intrusion.

St. Louis, July 10th.—The scheme to settle on Government lands in Indian Territory is gaining strength daily, and quite a letter to the Secretary of the Treasury, Judge Cradock, has been received from St. Louis. Cradock, a lawyer, and one of a company who came here a few days ago to work up the scheme, has received several letters from places in Illinois, stating that a number of persons will be here on Monday ready to go to the Territory. The scheme is being pushed forward from Arkansas City, at which point it is telegraphed to numerous parties and the Pacific Railroad to push on the line.

An Opium Corner.

NEW YORK, July 10th.—It is confidently stated that the New York syndicate representing a capital of about \$75,000,000, have formed a combination for the purpose of cornering the opium trade in the city. It is estimated that the growing crop will not amount to over 1,800 cases, and as the world's supply is estimated to amount to some 6,000, an immense profit is anticipated by the syndicate. The price in this city is 87 1/2 per pound, but the syndicate is considered very low. The syndicate has purchased largely of the present supply, and it is agents scattered in the remotest districts of the far East making contracts for the growing crop. Foreign manufacturers of opium are being driven out of business. The syndicate is said to be uneasy over the prospect. Mr. Dattil, President of the United Marine and Indian Land Insurance Company, a native of Smyrna, who is formerly in the opium trade, is reported to be at the head of the combination.

A Terrible Explosion.

PITTSBURGH, July 10th.—This morning at 2 o'clock, one of the seven boilers in Painter's iron mill, on the South Side, exploded with a loud report, killing Frederick Kable, the engineer, and William Black, a fireman. Both were buried under the debris, and were horribly mangled. Grable leaves a widow and a child, and Black leaves a wife and two children. The explosion was caused by a boiler which was completely wrecked. The cause of the explosion is unknown. The fact that thousands of gallons of water were thrown a great distance shows that the water was plenty. The loss to the building is \$5,000. The coroner's jury is investigating the cause of the explosion.
