DR. RIDGWAY'S HOLD POSITION ON THE

A CONFERENCE.

THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF THE
M. E. CHURCH SOUTH.

NASHVILLE (Tenn.), May 12, 1882.

The General Conference of the M. E. Church South, now in session in this city,

was expected by many to afford evidence

of a strong desire on the part of that church

for organic union with the Methodist

Church South, as it is called here. The signs of the

times, it was thought, justified such expectation.

Fraternity and union were in the air.

There had been in recent years a considerable

toning down of the political animosities

of the amalgamation of commercial interests

which the local organic union would

"Why then," reasoned the friends of union,

"should not the churches come closer together?"

The expectation that these two churches would speedily unite,

and that the present Conference would be the

allotted to favor and precipitate such union,

was strengthened, too, by the recent rapid

growth of the Methodist Church South, between the

two bodies. When, in 1848, FOUR YEARS AFTER THE SEPARATION,

Dr. Lovick Pearce, recently deceased, presented

himself before the General Conference of the

former body as a delegate from the new

Southern organization, and was told that he

could not be received, his response being that

the next overtures of friendliness would have to come from the

Northern church, the prospect for fraternal

union was supposed to be about as dark as it

well could be. It grew darker, however, as

the years advanced, and the wide extension

of church property and territorial jurisdiction

of the Methodist Church South, and with these

united the civil war broke out. This was a

very bad omen for the organic union, but

the Methodist Church South, as Dr. Ridgway

truly said in his fraternal address on

Wednesday, "The organic union of the

churches, of all religious organizations, fur-

nished to each side the largest number of

soldiers and sailors, and the largest number

of men in the army and navy. This was a

popular agency in solidifying public senti-

ment in favor of the organic union. This
