

One of the Most Unaccountable and Dangerous of Recent Deceits Discovers and Exposed.

There is some mysterious trouble that is attacking nearly everyone in the land with more or less violence.

It is indeed a modern mystery. Like those severe and vague maladies that attack horses and prostrate nearly all the animals in the land, this subtle trouble seems to menace mankind.

A House of the Stone Age. A very interesting discovery of a house of the stone age was recently made in a marsh at Schulsdorf, in Wurtemberg. The house or hut was still preserved; the flooring and part of the walls were intact, and, as appeared from a careful measurement, it was a square of about 32 feet on each side. The hut was divided into two compartments, communicating with each other by a foot-bridge made of three girders. The single door, looking toward the south, was about three feet wide, and opened into a room 19 feet long by 12 feet wide. In one corner lay a heap of stones, which had apparently formed the fireplace. This room was the kitchen, "the living-room," and probably a night refuge for the cattle in cold weather. The second room, which had no opening outside, measured about the same, and was no doubt used as the family bedchamber. The floors of both rooms were formed of round logs, and the walls of split logs. This, be it remembered, was a hut of the stone age. It may be safely presumed that the lake dwellings of the bronze age were larger in size and less primitive in their arrangements. At both periods the platform supporting the houses communicated with the shore by means of a bridge (probably removable at pleasure), and with the water by ladders. These ladders, as appears from an example found at Chavannes, were made of a single stang with holes for the staves, which protruded on either side.—Scientific Press.

A Too Modest Kalleboud. At the last session of the Arkansas Legislature a bill was introduced granting a charter to the Gulf and New England Railroad Company. That was all right, but the company wanted the power to issue bonds at five times the amount of its capital, and to oblige all exchangers to take its stock at par, while the State was to take a mortgage of \$2,000,000 to enable the company to commence the road.
