New York, November 28th.—The great annual Yale-Princeton football match took place at the Polo Grounds yesterday afternoon. It brought together the largest crowd which ever visited the Polo Grounds. The assemblage numbered over 11,000. There were over 10,000 present at an early hour yesterday. Fifth avenue was filled with four-hundred, loaded down with Princeton, Yale, Columbia, Harvard, Dartmouth and Wesleyan College students, shouting their respective college cries.

Another Bank Failure.

MIDDLETON (N. J.), November 28th.—The Middleton National Bank has failed. Its doors were closed this morning. The bank was organized in 1854 by Benjamin D. Brown, a grain dealer of Indianapolis and Burlington, without security. The bank's capital is \$200,000, surplus, \$115,000. The extent of the loss is not known.
