The Palo Alto Stables have had a small string of trotters in Charley Marvin's hands at the Bay District track for some days past, and early the week ending yesterday for yesterday were sent to a select few, each bearing the simple announcement of a private exhibition of youngsters. Up to a few months ago Governor Stanford held the best records for horses up to five years, the time of Bonita as a four-year-old in 1883 being 2:18. A Kentucky colt cut this by a quarter of a second last summer, and to Palo Alto the best record through 1884 it was necessary for a Palo Alto product to get around the circle in better than 2:18.
