The man was about 35 years of age, medium size, had false teeth, was clean shaven, and was dressed in a suit and a heavy overcoat. The jury returned a verdict that he came to his death from a gunshot wound inflicted by himself, or by some other person. The remains will be brought to this city today.

**SENATOR STANFORD.**  
Nelson (Butte county), January 28th.—Ex-Governor Stanford passed here at 8:30 P. M. on route to Vina. Huge crowds were turning out to see him, and the Legislature at the State Capitol was in session.

**EXPRESS TRAIN DERAILLED.**

**ARIZONA.**  
Punished for Sub.—Agent Hart, Tucson, January 28th.—Sub-Agent Hart, who is in charge of the Arizona Territory, near this city, is now serving a sentence of Judge W. Fitzgerald, of the District Court, for a five days imprisonment in the County Jail and to pay a fine of \$500 for contempt, in refusing to submit to an order of the court to produce a certain document. This trouble arose from the summary and brutal ejection by Wheeler of Mrs. Berger and family from her possessions, the title of which property in Arizona is now being contested by the Arizona Territory.

**A Divided Freight Train.**  
Tucson, January 28th.—The freight train here at 4 o'clock, and which was divided without the knowledge of the engineer, and when the fore part had come to a standstill at the station, the engine was started in reversing nearly the whole train, and smashing up eight cars. Two trains, starting a mile, received slight injuries. The road is now closed for the east-bound express this morning.
