CHINA.

**The Wickham Case.** Reports of the revolting murder of Captain and Mrs. Wickham have been confirmed by Marshall Blume and others who have arrived from the scene of the tragedy. Marshall Blume, Fred Wickham's son (son of J. G. Wickham), Elliott Jewell, Mr. Truitt and Mr. Skags first arrived at the scene eight hours in advance of any of the other parties. The position of the persons and circumstances of the case are as follows: Captain Wickham and his wife were seated at the table and the wine was being served. The warm biscuits were on the table and the stove and were but little used. The table was set with a white cloth and the table and chairs were of the best. The Wickham family had just returned from a party given in their honor at the residence of the late Mr. Wickham. His plate and food were returned in his lap. Mrs. Wickham jumped up, threw her chair, dropping her napkin on the floor, and ran to her bedroom. The Chinaman followed her and fired both charges at her, the shot passing through her body under the arms. Two empty cartridges were in the shot gun and two empty cartridges from the revolver had evidently been removed from the gun when it was reloaded after the shooting of Mrs. Wickham. The Chinaman then went to the kitchen and took a piece from the table and ate it. Mrs. Wickham jumped up, threw her chair, dropping her napkin on the floor, and ran to her bedroom. The Chinaman followed her and fired both charges at her, the shot passing through her body under the arms. Two empty cartridges were in the shot gun and two empty cartridges from the revolver had evidently been removed from the gun when it was reloaded after the shooting of Mrs. Wickham. The Chinaman then went to the kitchen and took a piece from the table and ate it.

MISREPRESENTING SACRAMENTO.

The San Francisco **Argument** of Saturday last, in referring to the attempt to pass a local law in Sacramento expelling all Chinese from the city, falls into some grave errors which we cannot permit to pass unchallenged. We can understand how the editor of the **Argument** may have fallen into the flagrant errors that lead him into gross misstatements, but cannot excuse his readiness to draw damaging conclusions.

In the first place, the proposed ordinance did not pass a first reading. There is no such ordinance known to our system. An ordinance may be presented, as was done in this case, by citizens, and its passage may be delayed, but it is not to be taken up for a second or third reading until it has been passed on its merits by a majority of the city council.

The **Argument** would be the last to deny this privilege or right. The custom is to then lay it over a week or more for proper consideration, except in urgent cases, the rules are, by unanimous consent suspended. In this case the document was laid on the table for one week after presentation by a committee of petitioning citizens. At the expiration of that time it was taken up and defeated, and this occurred sufficiently early for the **Argument** to have known the fact prior to its own date of issuance, since the news of defeat was published in all the daily papers of Sacramento early last week.

The **Argument** should have had the broadness of spirit and common justice to state that the press of Sacramento warmly opposed the ordinance, as did the mass of the people, and that its passage was not seriously contemplated save by exceeding few. Instead of this our San Francisco contemporary, by the tenor and phrasing of its condemnation, leads its readers to infer that the ordinance is still pending (having "already passed its first reading," as it puts it), and that there is a probability of its final passage.

Further in its article the **Argument** expresses the belief that it is the result of "unintentional" misstatements, that in Sacramento "committees have made dilatory citizens from house to house, warning manufacturers, millers, boarding-house keepers and women to discharge their Chinamen, under fear of arson and violence." In which last statement there is not a word of truth. No such threats have been made; not even rumor has given suspicious credence to such stories. A canvass was made to secure withdrawal of patronage from Chinese industries in favor of competing white labor, but that threats of violence and arson accompanied such a canvass is without foundation. On the assumption that its information is correct, the **Argument** is desirous, in its "indignation," "if a civil war breaks out," that it may begin in Sacramento, since it is the capital of the State, where the Governor resides, and where the State business is transacted.

The **Argument** says that the Chinese need not concern itself with that. The need has never arisen here for an x-banded brigade; nor have our gardeners ever been called from their homes to rest on their knees night after night to give confidence to fearful citizens. Sacramento has no snail nor O'Donnells, nor dynamite conspirators, nor marching columns breathing threatenings. Its citizens fear neither violence nor arson, nor do they anticipate the necessity for the Governor returning to his armor, and charging through the streets of Sacramento at the head of a second cavalry corps. The **Argument** should compose its nerves.

SENATOR FARLEY.
