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ALTAZ VS. KNICKERBOCKERS.

Meagher, in the fifth inning, struck out seven men in the five innings he pitched. McLaughlin played a great game behind the bat. Meagher pitched the Altaz to a victory, which was the first since McDonald did not support him in his usually accurate manner. Alben and the latter made a neat double play in the second inning with DePaughter. In the fifth inning Robertson struck out the men of the Altaz, and side out a ball over to steal home from third, and it looked like a success; but just then Barry hit the ball to left field, greatly to the regret of the Altaz.

Hayes made a fine run home from second in the sixth inning. McLaughlin's hit, in the seventh, was the only one that counted, and just then Hayes, after touching his base, started for third.
