OFFICIAL PROCLAMATION

providing that in all cases actions may be maintained against the Tax Collector's Treasury on each legal tax paid under protest. All such actions shall be made in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

Proclamation.

Nothing in this amendment shall affect any assessment or tax heretofore made or levied, or interest thereon, or any penalty heretofore incurred, or any action thereon, or any other right or claim in respect to any assessment, tax, interest or penalty, made or levied, or assessed, or collected, or paid, or otherwise affected, or to be affected, by this amendment.

AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE.

Section 1. All property in the State, except railroads, not exempt under the laws of the United States, shall be taxed in proportion to its value, to be ascertained as provided in this article.

Section 2.
