

TO-DAY'S LEADING NEWS TOPICS.

Gross negligence is charged against the quarantine authorities in New York harbor. In the Knights of Labor General Assembly a resolution of sympathy with the condemned anarchists was promptly squelched. A \$50,000 robbery occurred recently on the Pacific Express line in Arkansas. By a disaster in the Bay of Borneo twenty-two lives were lost. Eastern people are now crowding into the Southern counties. A hot north wind has prevailed all over the State for several days, causing great discomfort. The forest fires in Sonoma county yesterday swept over many miles of country, and destroyed a vast amount of property.

TEACHERS' CERTIFICATES.

Under the administration of Professor Welcker as State Superintendent of Public Instruction, his department held that, under the "Perry" amendment to the Constitution, all teachers' certificates must issue from the County Boards of Examination. At first the Constitution read that the local Boards of Education and Supervisors and Superintendents, "where there are no County Boards, shall have control of the examination of teachers and the granting of teachers' certificates within their several jurisdictions."

IN PARIS IT WAS.

The Women Involved in the War Office Scandal.

LONDON, October 10th.—The Cafarré-Limousin case in Paris is a scandal. Madame Limousin is a vulgar adventuress. She is forty-one years of age, a hump-backed, cross-eyed, and glaring-eyed. Last year she lived in Boulevard Beaumarchais with a companion who called her Comtesse de Boisler, baronne de Beaugard, de Clémenceville, and whose real name is Henriette Boissy Coquette. Madame Limousin also has a husband, an advocate of smaller caliber. The latter carried on the business of "influence agency" for the benefit of persons employed in the Ministries, promotion, Government contracts, etc. In reality, Madame Limousin and the Comtesse passed their time writing to politicians, notably to Baudin and Boulanger, letters containing flattery, threats, calumnies, offers of service and propositions of a corrupting character, and both Baudin and Boulanger finally warned them through the police, to cease their maneuvering. Then Limousin and the Comtesse were quarreled, and the former removed to a gorgeous suite of rooms in Avenue Wagram, where she continued her agency and entered into relations with General Galliffrey, an officer who has been disgraced with debts and has no longer any sense of honor or decency.

AN "ARKANSAW" TRAVELER.

The Pacific Express Out \$60,000, and a Messenger Missing.

LITTLE ROCK (Ark.), October 10th.—It is learned that a heavy robbery of the Pacific Express safe on the Iron Mountain road occurred a few days ago, but the facts in the matter have been suppressed. The amount taken is variously estimated at from \$30,000 to \$60,000. On reaching Texas the messenger in charge of the safe had to go to Dallas to see the Superintendent. He went and returned, then went to St. Louis and thence to Illinois. Since the discovery of the robbery the detectives have been searching for him without success. The messenger's name is J. D. O'Connell, one of the oldest and most trusted messengers in the service.
