CALIFORNIA SLAVERY AND THE SLAVE TRADE.

The slave-drivers of Sacramento, the boldest and most cruel of any in California, who pursued the victim Rev. Mr. Filben rescued from one of their dens last week, have met with a second defeat.

Defeated in all these moves, they hastened off to San Francisco and secured a writ of habeas corpus in the name of a man claiming to be the husband of the woman. But before Judge Tooley yesterday it was shown that she was not restrained of her liberty, and remained with her protectors of her free will, and besides she denied emphatically that she had a husband in the true sense, as she had been married under duress, and had never lived with him.

There is so much being said and charged and denied and conjectured concerning the State Prison, their management by the Directors and officials in charge, that it will not be surprising if an investigation is ordered.

Yet, this woman's case is but one of two thousand, for there are upwards of two thousand of these enslaved human beings in California, and the officers of the law make no effort to free them or give force and effect to that clause of the Federal Constitution which declares that "neither slavery nor involuntary servitude, except as a punishment whereof the party shall have been duly convicted, shall exist within the United States or any place subject to their jurisdiction."

In the teeth of this provision, for the establishment of which some of the best blood of the nation was spilled, and tens of thousands of American citizens laid down their lives, human slavery does exist and the slave trade is actively and openly carried on.

As an evidence of the growth of public opinion in favor of restriction upon the immigration of the undesirable classes we have the free utterance of most of the pulpits of the day approving the spirit of the sentiment. Here in California, on Sunday last, was found one of the most popular preachers of the metropolis declaring from the desk to his congregation that the importation of Anarchists and distributors of peace of society is becoming so dangerous that the avenues of immigration ought to be narrowed, and officers be absolutely closed to the offensive class.

PRISON SCANDALS.

They Continue to be Proliferous, But Do Not Materialize. The San Francisco papers continue to speculate as to whether Warden Shirley will be retained and Warden McCormick removed to San Quentin.

THE JUTE MILL AT THE PRISON.

The Legislature under the advice of the Directors of the State Prison provided that \$162,000 might be expended in erecting a jute-mill machinery at San Quentin. The one and only purpose of the Legislature was to employ the idle hands in the prison, the present works being insufficient for that purpose.

Directors with Governor Waterman, who is authorized under the general law of March, 1876, to pass with other officers upon the plans, drawings and specifications for all work upon State institutions, the Governor suggested a plan whereby the purpose of the Legislature could be carried out without expending the sum appropriated.
