THE CAPITAL. SENATOR YEST TO RETIRE FROM PUBLIC LIFE. The Chinese Treaty Sent to the President - Matters in Congress - Notes - Etc.

CONGRESSIONAL PROCEEDINGS. The Senate. WASHINGTON, March 14th. - In the Senate to-day, among the petitions and memorials received was a number from Ohio, Vermont and Montana for the protection of wool and woolen industries.

Additional session was inserted, authorizing the General Appraisers to call before them for a committee on each owner, importer, agent, consignee or person, touching importations, and to require the production of papers, real or pretended.

WASHINGTON, March 14th. - In the House the bill was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs. The Senate bill fixing the charge for passports at \$1 was passed.

Several private bills were passed and measure referred to the Court of Claims. The bill of the Hon. H. H. Jones, ex-ecutive of Emanuel Jones, gave rise to considerable discussion.

THE EAGLE PASS DIFFICULTY. WASHINGTON, March 14th. - The Secretary of State has received from the United States Consul at Peking a report, a full report of the recent trouble at Eagle Pass, Tex., between civil officers and Mexican troops.

THE CHINESE TREATY. WASHINGTON, March 14th. - Secretary Bayard said to-night that the treaty with China had been signed, and would be sent to the President at once for transmission to Congress.
