THE NEWS FROM THE SOUDAN.

The report of the capture of Emin Pasha by the Mahdi, although it comes through the Turkish Osman Digna, made the Khalifa over the Sudan, is so well authenticated as to leave scarcely any doubt as to its verity. But the rumored taking of Stanley by the False Prophet is a character to be credited. If the English press operations for the relief of Suakin it is probable that Emin will be executed. In that event we may expect the bitterest war in the valley of the Nile known in modern if not in all time.

SAN FRANCISCO AND VICINITY.

The Mariposa sailed for Australia yesterday afternoon. The Government is again paying his vacation. John Egan has been sentenced to ten years at Folsom for robbery. Hugh McConagh, an eleven-year-old boy, is reported missing near home. A number of vessels bound for this port are bar-bound at northern coast ports. George Monaghan was "stood up" in a room on Saturday and robbed of \$200. The District Attorney has moved to dismiss the indictment against Luke Cary for murder. A nine-days' go-as-you-please race will commence at the Mechanics' Pavilion February 21st.

DE LESSEPS' LOST HOPE.

The Chamber of Deputies Refuses to Aid the Canal Company. LONDON, December 16th.—The Panama Canal Company is doomed, the last effort to obtain the Government aid having failed. In the Chamber of Deputies last night the bill submitted by M. Peytral, Minister of Finance, authorizing the company to suspend the payment of interest on its bonds for three months, was reported adversely by the special committee appointed under vote of urgency to consider it. A long and excited debate followed. Patriotic appeals were made to the house to sustain the great enterprise with which the honor and pride of the nation were bound up. On the other hand, bitter denunciations were heard of the mismanagement of the affairs of the company, of wanton extravagance and of the appropriation of funds, and of wholesale corruption of the press and deception of the public. There were many violent scenes and the President of the Chamber was obliged to suspend the sitting. Finally, amid excitement so intense that it nearly quitted the Chamber, the majority voted to reject the committee's report and it was adopted by a vote of 292 to 118.

AT HARRISON'S HOME.

A Quiet Day—Arrival of a Unique Gift from Nebraska. INDIANAPOLIS, December 16th.—The incident which resulted in a rather poor attendance at the churches this morning, General Harrison passed to quiet duty at home. Hon. W. New received a letter from Senator Quay stating that he would leave Washington on Monday night for Indianapolis. Two of the correspondents of the journals saw said to be engaged in the name of Harrison's cabinet in the person of Governor J. B. Foraker to whom they assigned the Attorney Generalship. Boulanger Ups that He Would Like to be President. PARIS, December 16th.—General Boulanger frankly admits that he would like to be President of France. He is confident he will be some day. He denies that he is plotting war or a coup d'etat. He sees corruption in the Chamber of Deputies, and he would like to see it abolished. Half of France, he says, is at his back in the movement to reform the French Constitution. General Sheridan was his ideal cavalry general, and he also speaks enthusiastically of General Sherman. He would like to see the names of Sherman, Sherman and others as memorials of his trip to the United States in 1881.

THE SEIZED STEAMER.

Departure of a Crew to Take Possession of the Haytian Republic. KINROSS, December 16th.—The Jamaica steamer, the "Havannah," which was captured by Port au Prince, carrying Captain Williams, of the Alene, and a crew to take charge of the steamer Haytian Republic. They expected to reach Port-au-Prince today. The captive steamer will be taken in tow if desired and possession be taken by the Minister of Marine, being kept from knowing anything. Only Legation and the Captain of the port will be seen. Captain Williams has a letter from Minister Preston to Legation.

A \$400,000 STEEL.

Where a Goodly Share of the Indiana Campaign Funds Went. INDIANAPOLIS, December 16th.—The fact has just been made public that \$400,000 which was raised by the Third Club of Indianapolis for the Indiana campaign, was appropriated by the men who were entrusted with its delivery to the State. It was not used for the purposes intended, but their names are to be permitted to leak out, that they may be objects of public contempt.
