HANDLING A WRECK.

AN ANIMATED SCENE NEAR DAVISVILLE YESTERDAY.

Raising Engineer Cox's Locomotive From the Mud—Bringing Over the Late Washout.

Persons who have never seen a railroad wrecking crew at work have little idea of the systematic and skillful manner in which these men are trained to handle a wreck.

A Record-Upton reporter, through the courtesy of the railroad, visited the scene of the disastrous washout two miles this side of Davisville yesterday, where Charles Cox, the unfortunate engineer of the Knights Landing train, was killed Friday night, and fireman Neal badly injured.

The break, as was previously published, was caused by the sudden rising of Putah creek. The swollen stream dashed with irresistible force against the embankment upon which the track was laid, and, after a wide opening directly through and under the rails, leaving the latter in their proper places but unsupported underneath.

It being dark at the time the ill-fated train came along, Engineer Cox, with the aid of the locomotive headlights, could only see the unbroken track ahead of him and could not discern the washout underneath. The regular track-patrolman had been over the road some time before the accident occurred, and was discovering the washout went back to Davisville and reported it.

Several section men started out immediately for the scene, intending to signal the train and thus avert the disaster, but they did not reach the washout in time, however, and the train plunged into the break, and the engine and several of the cars were hurled hither and thither, some carrying heavy beams on their shoulders, others great open poles, and others carrying sledge-hammers, axes and a hundred and one other devices.
