

A LION ON HORSEBACK

Description of the Performance of the Young "Prince Leo."

Speaking of one of the sensations of the holidays, the fifteen-month-old horseback lion, the Pull Mall Gazette says: I was introduced to him at a rehearsal which took place in the arena of the Opera House yesterday afternoon. It was his debut in the English saddle, and he thoroughly enjoyed himself. Do not, tender readers, imagine that Prince Leo is let loose in the ring. No, he is young and playful now, but some day he might take it into his handsome head to make a leap into the stalls and make off with a plump morsel which he never intended for his horse's meat before measures could be taken to stop him. A circular cage is run up in the ring with a conical top piece, which is let down from the upper regions as a lid. A pretty little white horse with a lovely white tail, with a white mane, and an arrangement of armor on his mane, is trotting round the ring.

All is ready, and a gang of men wheel up a gorgeous den to the door of the cage. Out bounds the lovely young lion, a splendid young beast in admirable condition, roaring and gnashing his teeth, rolling his eyes and whirling his tail around. I take it that these signs denoted his pleasure at greeting his old friend, the white horse with a flowing tail. Before the lion had got well out he was ordered by a specialist Russian band-bound, which led him with him in perfect amity. The trainer is a German, short, well-built little man, with a pair of fine mustaches. He is armed with a whip only, and immediately orders the lion to take his place on a wooden pedestal about five feet high, which he does with a pleasurable placidity. Then the performance begins. After showing his obedience to his master with just a snarl and a growl or two to mark time, he is ordered to leap from his pedestal on to the horse's back, a feat which he accomplishes with ease and grace. The horse then cantered around the ring, the dog following, and the trainer in the center with his eye always on the lion. The horse is a small one, not much bigger than a pony, in fact, and it is quite wonderful how the lion takes to his rider, who scales sixteen feet, and is then fixed up high enough for the horse to pass under. Prince Leo mounts and jumps from the horse's back onto the platform. It is very comical to see the Prince crouching on a platform with his head bent down to watch the approach of the horse. He repeated this feat several times without a hitch, and with a grace which made the performance not only wonderful but pleasant to watch. Virtue is rewarded with a lump of meat. Next he is ordered to jump over the dog and the lion then around the ring, taking a hurdle on the way with great pleasure, though Prince opened his mighty jaws and roared in tones which made me glad of the iron barrier. For the last act the lion jumps over the platform, and is fired a pistol. A lump of meat dangled from a string attached to the trigger, and that was how it was done. The lion, by the way, comes from Hamburg, and is the property of Hakenbach, the famous animal dealer.

This surely cannot be the condition to which our fathers reduced us when they entered into the compact of union. Allegiance is everywhere due to the sovereign only. The sovereign, under the American system, is the People—the People of the State to which the individual belongs, the People who constitute the State government, which he obeys; the People who alone, as far as he is concerned, are the authors of the Federal Constitution; the People who never delegated their sovereignty, and therefore retain the power to revoke agencies created by them.—Jefferson in North American Review.
