ANOTHER HORROR.

A Score of Workmen Buried in the Ruins of a Building. CHICAGO, March 27th.-Shortly after 6 o'clock this evening the men were preparing to leave the big sugar refinery on the corner of Beecan and Taylor streets, when the largest boiler exploded. The flames caused by the explosion reached the starch department, when another explosion occurred, and three floors of the refinery were actually blown to atoms. A large number of men at work in the refinery were killed, and the bodies of twenty or thirty men are supposed to be buried. At 9 o'clock the men were recovered, and the work is being pushed.
