Gen. Scott arrived safely in Buffalo this morning. He received an enthusiastic reception, and is in good health.

BALTIMORE, Oct. 12—24 p. m.

The steamer America has arrived at Halifax. Her news has not yet been received.

THE Trial of Bishop Doane.
BURLINGTON, N. J., Oct. 8.—The House of Bishops met in the City Hall, in this city, this morning, in pursuance of a motion to adjourn made yesterday at Camden.

Eighteen bishops were present, viz: Hopkins, of Vermont; Burgess, of Maine; Chase, of New Hampshire; Eastburn, of Massachusetts; Delaney, of New York; Potter, of Pennsylvania; Lee, of Delaware; Mende and Johns, of Virginia; Whittingham, of Maryland; Rutledge, of Florida; Green, of Mississippi; Smith, of Kentucky; Kemper, of Wisconsin; Upfold, of Indiana; McCrocker, of Michigan; McIlvaine, of Ohio; Doane, of New Jersey.

Bishop Hopkins, of Vermont, presides, in the absence of Bishop Brownell, of Connecticut, who is absent on account of illness.

The Rev. Dr. Wainwright, of New York, is secretary; and the Rev. J. H. Hopkins, jr., of New Jersey, is assistant secretary.

The sessions are held with closed doors, and I cannot therefore give any extended report.

BURLINGTON, Oct. 9.—The House of Bishops commenced this morning at 10 o'clock. The same number is present.

The presentment against Bishop Doane was read, and also the report of the committee of the New Jersey Convention. It is understood that the presenting bishops asked until Monday next to answer it.

There is very little excitement here upon the subject, except among those connected with the Episcopal Church. It is understood that a motion will be made to have the trial public.

The committee for the presenting bishops are Richard S. Coxe, esq., of Washington; H. W. Davis, esq., of Baltimore; and William Halsted, esq., of Trenton. For the defence are Messrs. T. L. Wharton and Meredith, of Philadelphia; Messrs. Carpenter, Browning, and Stratton, of New Jersey, and Judge Chambers, of Maryland.

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 11.—All the \$3 seats for Sonntag's first concert were sold to-day with a rush. She will be received on Wednesday night by a band of three hundred Turners with torches.

ESCAPE OF A CONVICT.—William E. Crissey, a convict, escaped from the Eastern Penitentiary on Saturday evening. He disguised himself in a suit of clothes which he was making for a convict whose term had expired, and by this means escaped detection by the gate keeper.

FLORIDA ELECTION.
