AMERICAN TELEGRAPH. (From this morning's Republic.) Respect to Daniel Webster.

On the invitation of Messrs. John W. Mason, W. W. Seaton, R. C. Weightman, Peter Ferris, and Walter Lenox—the first named Mayor of Washington, and the others ex-Mayors of this city—a large number of the citizens met, last night, in the Council Chamber, City Hall, for the purpose of adopting suitable measures with reference to the death of Daniel Webster.

Mr. Lenox called the meeting to order, and on his motion his honor, the Mayor of the city, was called to the chair.

Messrs. Nicholas Callan and John B. Blake were appointed secretaries.

On motion of Mr. Carlisle, Messrs. Seaton and Lenox were requested to act as vice presidents; and, on motion of the same gentleman, it was Resolved, That a committee of nine members be appointed by the chairman to prepare resolutions expressive of the deep sympathy of this meeting and of the community on account of the death of Daniel Webster.

In pursuance of this resolution, the following-named gentlemen were appointed said committee: J. M. Carlisle, P. R. Fendall, Joseph Bryan, John Hellen, Jacob Gideon, Judge Crawford, S. H. Hill, F. A. Tucker, and Benjamin A. Beall.

The committee, after a brief absence returned, when Mr. CARLISLE said: I have been requested by the committee to present to this meeting a series of resolutions. In doing so, I do not feel myself equal to the task of prefacing them by remarks which are usual on such occasions. I will not say that I feel on this occasion more than I suppose every other American must feel. Although it was my fortune to know the illustrious deceased, and although I was personally attached to him, all personal affections which may have been felt for him are now merged in the feelings akin to patriotism, which absorb the whole heart of the whole American people when such a man dies.

Feeling as an American, and standing in the presence of Americans, it is scarcely necessary that I should utter a single word. If I feel that the constitution has lost its noblest prop, so do they feel. If my mind reverts to signal occasions when he has combated dangers which surrounded the constitution, and triumphantly sustained it, so do their minds revert in grateful reverence to the same memorable scenes. If in my mind he is associated with all that belongs to the glory and dignity of our country and the perpetuity of our institutions, so are the like associations now filling every mind and heart around me.

To-morrow his body is to be consigned to the earth, at a place far distant from us. I know that his heart will swell, and the tear unbidden start from many an eye, when the imagination pictures that scene. Yet while we stand in spirit beside his grave, the feeling of relief grief will be almost lost in the triumphal recollection that such a man is the offspring of our own soil—that such a mind and such powers, and such a great and comprehensive heart, have been developed by our own home-bred institutions; that what he has done has been done not for today, or to-morrow, but for all time; that it has been grafted by him in the constitution, to grow and flourish with that constitution—to last while the constitution lasts. Beyond that day he would not live, nor will I. And yet, sir, we have been accustomed to see him day by day in our walks; witnesses of the constancy of his devotion to duty; who have seen, and felt, and known the happy influence which such a man and such a mind must ever exercise, we do not, cannot look at him as a being merely existing in history, but realizing him as a man whose hand we have pressed, and shall press no more; as a man whose bright and friendly smile we have witnessed, but shall witness no more. We who saw him as a husband, father, and friend—we cannot forget that on this earth
