


THE FIRST ENTRY MADE BY HALF MOON was a drawing of the killing of Moore. The white man is depicted in a high state of alarm...




DRIVING OFF HORSES. A successful horse raid. He invariably distinguishes between horses captured from the United States government...




KILLING A SOLDIER. Taken mutually over a stream or some vessel of water. In Half Moon's case a coffee pot served the purpose...



Effect of a Rival of a New Bonnet. Husband—Mary, I saw a very handsome bonnet as I came down the street this morning...




