

WORSE THAN A BRUTE. THE AWFUL CRIME OF A FRENCHMAN.

Brutally Murdered His Mistress' Child and Concealed Her Under the Bed.

The Crime Confessed Without Signs of Remorse—Consigned to the Guillotine.

A Startling Story of Human Depravity in the French Capital—Murderer Sought Guilty at Marion, Ind., on His Wife's Testimony—Crime News.

PARIS, May 9.—A meek, inoffensive-looking man of middle age at the Paris Assizes today was tried and condemned to death for a double crime almost unparalleled in atrocious savagery. The monster is Jean Vodable, a Paris carver, Vodable used to live with a scavenger, Marie Malflatre, who, after three years' experience, wearied of her lover's brutal usage and showed him the door. Breathing threats of vengeance, Vodable went away and remained absent a month. On the morning of November 30 Mrs. Malflatre found Vodable in her apartment. He urged her to resume her former relations, emphasizing his entreaties by showing her a rope with which he said he would hang himself in case of refusal. Mrs. Malflatre compromised matters, agreeing to spend the day with Vodable. She had a daughter, Alexandrine, 12 years old, whom she supposed to be her own child. When mid day came Alexandrine did not return. At luncheon time her mother grew anxious, but Vodable quieted her by saying that he had given Alexandrine 3 sous to let her buy her meal at Vodable. The afternoon was passed by Vodable and Mrs. Malflatre in quarrelling battles of words. At twilight gathered and Alexandrine still did not return, her mother's anxiety revived. Accompanied by Vodable, she went in the school where she learned that Alexandrine had not attended. Thence she went to the police station. Finally she set on foot, but nothing was learned of the missing child. Exhausted, tired and disconsolate, Mme. Malflatre went home, still in company with Vodable, who passed the night at her house. Vodable took his leave in the morning and Mrs. Malflatre set about trying her room. While thus engaged she noticed a bit of red cloth protruding from under the bed. The woman staggered back in terrible fear, then she stooped down and pulled the cloth towards her. It was her child's nightgown, which she found at last. Shrieking, the mother ran through the house, and when the alarmed neighbors entered the house they found the helpless mother lying insensible upon the corpse of her child.

Medical examination showed that a brutal assault had been committed upon the girl, and suspicion was at once directed to Vodable, who after keeping the police at bay for a couple of days, gave himself up on his own accord, confessing that he was guilty of the crime of murder. His counsel, at the opening of the trial, begged a remand in order that Vodable might undergo a medical examination. This was refused by the presiding judge, who forthwith began his cross-questioning. Vodable answered composedly, almost carelessly, and kept looking at the judge and the persons present were there for his amusement. Vodable had suffered several condemnations for wounding with knife or revolver the women with whom he had lived. He lightly acknowledged that he had shot one woman and stabbed another in moments of exasperation. He stoutly maintained that he had been an industrious and temperate workman, adding, "I was a great fool to bear with her as long as I did."

Concerning the murder, the judge asked the prisoner to relate the details. "Viable" said Vodable found Alexandrine getting ready to go to school and asked her about visits paid to her mother. She said she could tell nothing, as it was not her business. "I said, 'you don't tell me I'll bring your neck.' I took her and wring her neck."

A SHEDDER MAN THROUGH THE AUDIENCE. Vodable had to take the witness stand in his own defense, but he was unceremoniously ordered out of the courtroom by the judge. "Then I pushed her under the bed."

Vodable's counsel made strenuous efforts to save his client's neck, depicting him as a genuine lover who had been misled, but the jury admirably pitiless returned a verdict of guilty. Vodable listened impressively to the sentence which consigned him to the guillotine.

A POLICEMAN'S ASSAULT TAKEN. KANSAS CITY, Mo., May 10.—John A. Ballard, a carpenter living at 218 Charlotte street, was arrested this morning, charged with being one of the assailants of Policeman Crowley, who was shot Tuesday night. He was taken before Crowley, who positively identified him as one of the two men who did the shooting. The officers are on the track of the other man, whom they think will soon be apprehended. Crowley will recover.

A LARGE DEFALCATION. ABERY, N. Y., May 10.—A defalcation in the City National bank amounting to nearly \$50,000 has been traced to George P. Whitney, the individual bookkeeper, who managed it through an overland system in collusion with a prominent Albany firm. An effort will be made among Whitney's friends to settle the affair. He had been in the bank for years and occupied a high social position. Stock speculation was the cause.

CONVICTED BY HIS WIFE'S EVIDENCE. MARION, Ind., May 10.—The case of the state of Indiana, against John Sage, charged with the murder of Harry A. Cunningham, which has been on trial here the past week, was concluded this afternoon with a verdict of guilty. Sage's punishment was fixed at imprisonment for life.

GRAVE IRREGULARITIES ALLEGED. NORTHWEST, Pa., May 10.—It is given out that grave irregularities have been discovered in the accounts of the Northwest Water company. The directors who have been questioned about the matter admit there is a large shortage in the cash, but will give no figures.

ONLY THE BEGINNING. War to the Death Being Waged on the Chicago Carpenters.

CHICAGO, Ill., May 10.—The old master carpenter's association, which refused to take part in the arbitration proceedings with the striking carpenters, is making a strong fight to secure men. It is forming a union of non-union men in opposition to the regular union and has agents in various points of the country and Canada endeavoring to get men. The carpenter's council has secured the presence here of a new government agent to look out for Canadian carpenters imported under contract and has 20 pickets out watching all contractors in the bank of the old association. In the mean time the new association is receiving accessions to its ranks and nearly all of the union carpenters are at work. The old bosses' association is making a strong fight on the new association which is chiefly made up of men of small means. The old association has made an

arrangement with the dealers in lumber and other building supplies by which the latter have agreed not to sell to the new bosses except on cash, which will cripple many of them seriously, as thirty to sixty days time is allowed the old bosses. The latter have also decided to defend all contractors in competition with the new bosses at prices which will allow of little or no profit and they will take advantage of the state conspiracy law to fight the strikers at all possible points. The union carpenters in their fight will rely upon their ability to call out the masses of brick layers and other building trades from all jobs where non-union men are employed and upon keeping carpenters from accepting service under the old bosses. In view of all these things, it seems that the struggle for an eight hour day in this city is only fairly begun instead of being at an end.

DEFIED AN OFFICER. German Seaman Refuse to Recognize the Law on Shipboard.

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., May 10.—A collector in the employ of an outfitting firm was aboard the German ship Theodor, which is anchored in the bay here, to collect some money from the third mate, Wolfold. Wolfold repudiated the debt, and after an altercation, with a knife, he cut the collector down. The latter went ashore and secured a warrant for Wolfold's arrest on a charge of battery. The warrant was given to Officer Maloney, who went to the ship in a small boat, accompanied by two boatmen. As the boat approached the vessel the ladder was hoisted up, but after making an explanation to the first mate, Schukin, the ladder was lowered and Officer Maloney allowed to go aboard, although the ladder was drawn down immediately to prevent the boatmen from following him. Maloney went into the cabin with Schukin and Wolfold and after some parley placed him (Wolfold) on deck. Schukin, however, went on deck, and as Wolfold refused to go with the officer he latter led him out of the cabin. When they reached the deck a crew of twelve crew members gathered and Mate Schukin pointed to the German flag floating astern and informed Maloney that a German ship could not take Wolfold. Maloney attempted to push his way through the crowd with his charge, but the crew closed around him, grasping him by the arms and rescued the prisoner. The boatmen, hearing the disturbance, jumped on the ladder, which had again been let down, and after making an explanation to the ladder ropes with a knife, but the boatmen told him they would shoot him if he did so, and they came aboard. Officer Maloney then ordered to go ashore for help, and as he left the ship the crew shouted expressions of contempt. Captain Dunley of the harbor police led the facts before Captain Maloney, who was ashore at the time, and the officer again went aboard the ship and arrested both mates, but without any further discussion Captain Hawes gave bail for both. The ship will sail in a day or two.

PRESENTED TO THE QUEEN. Americans Eager to Be Seen by Her Majesty.

LONDON, May 10.—A heavy, cold rain spoiled the queen's drawing-room from an outdoor point of view. A few hundred people gathered in the drawing-room, and umbrellas braved the elements, but had no reward, as all carriages had their windows up and the rain fell in a steady stream. As the queen entered the room was a great success, there being over 300 presentations, and there was a sharp drawing of the line. One of the fashionable florists, near Cavendish square, made up more than 100 bouquets at an average cost of 5 guineas each. Two of the most beautiful of these had been carried by the tall and lovely Duchess of Portland and another of pale pink and purple orchids in the hands of Mrs. Beckett of Kirkstall, formerly Miss Lee of New York.

The eagerness displayed by Americans for presentation to the queen was prominent for this season of the year. A number of United States citizens applied to the lord chamberlain direct, a shocking mode of attempt, and were refused. The legation, who found it necessary to issue a special circular for the information of the citizens, stated that as the citizens still on your side of the Atlantic should take note that United States citizens who would be received at court, as if they were of the royal household, the facility of bowing to Queen Victoria at a cost in dress alone of from \$500 to \$1,000 each, and the presentation
