

WICHITA MARKETS

The supply of cattle was fair for closing day. The receipts consisted mostly of fair to good butcher cows and heifers. The market was active and prices were strong for the quality. More cattle changed hands today on this market than for some time. The demand is active on good fat butcher grades. The feeling was strong at the close on this class of cattle. Thin and half fat cattle sold and prices very low. No demand for stock steers at present. Hogs came from every direction today and the supply outnumbered any previous days receipts by several hundred. Everybody had all the hogs they could handle at the close of the market, and seven or eight cars were unsold. The market was rather active and prices were well sustained through out. Bulk of packers' grades \$4.75 to \$5.50. Lights \$3.85 and Mexico \$3.47 to \$3.50. The buyers were all filled up and did not try much to break the price on account of the heavy run. The close was rather weak.




Mrs. Asenath Miller was born in Brimfield, Mass., the 13th of August, 1787, and removed with her father's family to Cherry Valley, N. Y.
