THE FAIR WEEK.

ALL INTERESTS HAVE COMBINED TO MAKE IT A SUCCESS.

Every Day a Banner Day With Special Ceremonies and Attractions—Special Premiums, Races, Military Parades, Music, Fine Exhibits, Novelties and Perfect Accommodations.

THE organization of the present fair association a marked and general interest has been manifested in the success of the fair by all classes. Farmers and merchants have joined hands with all comers having the success of the fair a common object. All have put their shoulders to the wheel, with what effect will be best known the 26th day of September when the gates will be opened to the public. The prospects could not be brighter, and those who know say it is an assured success already. Should the week be fine there are not sufficient hotel accommodations to house the visitors. The railroads have made a one fare for the round trip, and with others have bent their energies toward making the fair a big success numerically. The management will see to it that it is a success in other ways, while the products of the district can make it a wonder to all comers. The entry books for all classes of exhibits will be opened on Monday morning next and it is desirable that all exhibits should attend to their entries at once. If this matter is neglected too long there will be some dissatisfaction about space. Although the buildings are large and complete, every available space will be occupied and only the most economical arrangement of this space will enable them to accommodate all.

The judges will be selected with a view to getting experts in all classes and the usual haphazard way of picking them up on a moment's notice and at random will be avoided as much as possible.

No gambling of any kind is to be allowed on the grounds and all of the arrangements are such as to win the approval of all right minded people.

The electric cars will run to the main entrance and the railway company guarantees to have cars enough to handle the people with ease.

The inconvenience heretofore experienced in getting away from the grounds will be obviated, and the patrons of the fair will be able to get back and forth with comfort and dispatch. The run will be less than twenty minutes, and the cars will be run at two minute intervals if necessary to avoid overcrowding.

One of the features of the fair not already advertised will be the military exhibition. The second regiment proposes to go into camp for the entire week, and on Thursday night a camp fire with all its novelties and sports will add to the attractions of the grounds. A sham battle will also be fought on Thursday, and the preparations warrant the belief that it will be a grand affair.

A regularly organized police force commissioned by the police commissioner, will preserve the best of order and will contain a sufficient number of men to guide and direct visitors to any part of the grounds. All of the bands in the city will be in attendance and several outside bands of note will also be present for the afternoon exercises. Most all of the states will be represented by headquarters on the ground, and one section of the fair will be a miniature city of tents. Bunting and decorations of all kinds will add to the gaiety of the scene and it will be a fine week indeed.

Arrangements are being perfected now looking to the running of special trains on the different lines of railway, and as it must be apparent to all that the regular trains can not begin to accommodate the travel, it is to be hoped that the trains may be put on.

C. A. Phillips, who has just returned from a trip through the southern portion of the state, reports everybody enthusiastic on the subject of the district fair. Many people and excellent exhibits may be looked for. Everyone seems to realize that in order to successfully compete for any one of the special premiums offered it will be absolutely necessary to have the best, and it is fair to presume that no exhibition can possibly excel that of this district fair.

Mr. Joseph Fuhrman will endeavor to have one of the best displays of fine draft horses ever seen in any state, and is working among his competitors to have them do the same thing. He says the fair this fall promises to be the greatest ever held, and he should be a fair judge for he has followed them through Kansas and the Eastern states for years.

Monday will be known as "Opening Day," Tuesday as "Breeder's Day," Wednesday as "Alliance Day," Thursday as "Wichita Day," Friday as "Children's Day" and Saturday as "Everybody's Day."

It is at present intended that the opening will be made a feature and a drawing program is being arranged for and will be announced as soon as fully completed. The grounds will be lighted at night by electric lights and on certain evenings the program will call for special entertainments.

The farmers are taking hold of the matter with a will and everyone will be greatly surprised if it is not the banner fair of the state this year.

The races will be the most exciting ever held here and on certain evenings the best of the west will be looking for fresh laurels on this track.
