WOMEN WHO SCRIBBLE. ONE OF THEM DESCRIBES THEIR WORK AND THEIR TROUBLES. Not All Editors Think They Make Good Reporters, but Some Hall Them as the Best "Newspaper Men" in the Land.

NEW YORK, Sept. 15.—"If I had my way," said the city editor of a prominent New York daily, "I would fire every woman who dared to stick her nose in the office. Women writers are a nuisance. They never have their copy ready on time; they are either squabbling among themselves or making eyes at the managing editor. I don't like the rustle of petticoats around a newspaper office."

More gallant and chivalrous is a well known western editor, who writes: "I think women are making the best newspaper men of the country. I am decidedly in favor of their entering journalism."

Whether the editor who vouchsafed the first was suffering from a fit of despondency is not known. To be charitable it fancy he had met some unpleasant types of the woman scribbler, and he was committing the error of judging the mass by the few.

There is the feminine smart Aleck who delights in a vivid and stirring description of the manner in which she got the better of an antagonistic editor. She draws a select circle about her, and recites her tale of woe in a highly dramatic way, repeating slowly and with emphasis every word of the letter she wrote which brought him to a proper sense of his inferiority.

All these our actors are types familiar to any one engaged in newspaper work. But after all there is the ideal feminine journalist—broad, genial, self-possessed, alert, wide awake, business like, but yet a woman. Though she associates mainly with men she conserves her femininity. She does not ape their dress or manners.
