Its stockholders have made good the amount of the theft. They have also offered \$4,000 as a reward for the return of the money and \$2,000 for the arrest and conviction of the thief or thieves.

On the morning of Monday, March 19, 1894, the officers of this bank discovered a robbery of \$15,700.

This is supposed to have occurred between 6 p. m. Saturday, March 17th, and 8 p. m. Sunday, March 18th, 1894.

Extra precautions have been taken to make it impossible for this to occur again.

No loss can result as a depositor for the amount of the money deposited with the bank.
