

THEY LIKE SPOOKS

Supernatural Happenings in the Old French Quarter.

Haunted Houses Are Particularly Popular with the Creoles - A Young Spirit in White and Her Midnight Promenade.

The old French quarter of New Orleans is remarkable for the number of its mysterious characters and haunted houses, writes a Cincinnati Enquirer correspondent.

Whenever a murder or mysterious death occurs in a house, the superstitious Creoles at once flock upon the house as being haunted. These mysterious characters are generally supposed to have something to do with these haunted houses, or why their mystery?

One of these characters is a large man, with a big shock of hair on his head, more like a horse's mane than human hair, and a mustache like a shoemaker. He carries a large cane and umbrella and wears an overcoat, even in summer. He is usually seen in a doorway peeping out as if fearing the approach of somebody, and not venturing out until he has looked in all directions. He carries greasy, torn letters in all his pockets, also printed circulars of large financial schemes, addressed to himself, and he will ask strangers to read them. In a moment he will abruptly take his letters, and with a "good day" rapidly disappear.

What he does and how he becomes possessed of this money is the mystery. His identity and place of residence are also a part of the mystery. It is believed, however, that he lives in the damp, deserted, ivy-covered roadway on St. Louis, near Bourbon street, said to be haunted. The curious have watched the mysterious character, but all efforts to locate his abode have failed. The mystery deepened into a suspicion, and some years ago he was suspected of being "Jack, the Ripper," of Whitechapel.

He claims to know the secrets of chemistry, and that he possesses the power of converting brass into gold. His confidence has been betrayed, and the police now have an eye upon him, as well as the superstitious Creoles, who fear his supposed supernatural powers. In this house some years ago a dead body was found. There was no clue as to who the dead man was, but slight marks on two of his fingers showed that he had worn rings. As the rings were missing, it is supposed that they were diamonds, and that the man had been murdered for his jewelry and money, and the body taken upstairs into this unoccupied house. Since that time it has been known as "haunted."

There is another haunted house on St. Peter's street, and far from the cathedral. The superstitious Creoles say that on a dark night after twelve o'clock the form of a young woman in white can be seen walking along the broad piazza that runs the length of the building.

Why the spiritual and spirituelle lady selects such an hour and costume for her parade is not explained by the ghost-seers.

The story of this ghost is the usual story of a nice young lady who wishes to marry a nice young man with a handsome and can dance lovely, while the hard-hearted father insists upon her marrying a man who has whiskers all over his face and cannot dance, but owns a few brick houses, and knows how to collect the rents promptly. It was so in this case, and thereby hangs the ghost.

The father told his daughter that love was a matter of education, and that she could as easily cultivate a passion for a wealthy man as for a poor one, and, furthermore, told her that she was too young to love sincerely, and now was the time to plant her affections properly. She had scorned to do this, and she was finally delivered upon her head a Leah the Forsaken curse if she should marry the idiot of her choice.

This is exactly what she did by the aid and confidence of her mother, an elopement being planned. In due time the young man whom she loved so much deserted her. After a few weeks of extreme poverty, she sought out the parental roof. It rags and almost starving she rang the door bell. Her father met her at the door. He recognized her war features, but, still unforgetting, said: "No, you are not my daughter; she is dead!"

The poor woman left, thoroughly repentant and crying miserably. She returned next morning, knowing that her father would be at his place of business, and that her mother would not turn her away.

When her father returned she knelt at his feet and asked for his forgiveness. He pushed her from him, saying: "No, you are not my daughter; she is dead!" She then went to her room and stabbed herself to death.

A few days after the burial the father disappeared.

About a year afterwards the mystery was cleared up by the finding of his skeleton in a garret room.

But his spirit never appears; he is evidently satisfied where he is.
