

HOG MARKET DECLINES

Good Run of Hogs and Quality Fair.

TOPS REST ON \$4.22 1-2

Cattle Steady With a Good Line of Stock.

The Wichita hog market yesterday was at all times in line with all the other western markets. The quotation was steady on the opening and closed lower. There was a very good day for receipts and the trading was active and the demand good. The wagon supply was especially strong and all from this division sold at once and at good figures. Both the hog and the cattle departments showed an increased volume of receipts and the tone of both divisions was strong, comparatively. There were five cars of hogs which crossed the scales, and they ranged from light to medium and heavy. The demand was good and all of the offerings from the several departments were taken at once, and at prices satisfactory to the seller. The average weight was about the same as for the day previous, there being only a 2 pounds difference, this being in favor of yesterday. The receipts were greatly in excess of the day before, and in all it was a very satisfactory day all around. The quality of the car hogs was very fair, all being made up of fair mediums. The local packing demand was keen and lively, and all hogs on sale were snapped up at very fair prices. All the other western markets reported a falling off in the quotation and price, and this point was better than holding its own, and only the last few sales on the closed showed the influence of sympathetic action. Most of the time throughout the day the quotation was steady and only later, after most of the car lots had been sold, did the lower tone of other points influence this market any. In all, it was a very satisfactory day, and the market was on a basis entirely satisfactory to the shippers.
