BROUGHT TO A CLOSE

Teachers' Institute Adjourns After Appropriate Exercises
ACCOMPLISH GOOD WORK
Characterized by Enthusiasm --Resolutions are Offered.

The closing session of the Sedgwick county teachers' normal institute was held yesterday at the Lewis Academy. The first part of the session was devoted to the usual classes and all of the recitations were interesting because of the closing discussions on some of the most important topics which have come up during this session. The last hour of the morning was devoted to a program consisting of music and short talks from the instructors. Miss Kathryn Schofield sang a very pretty selection, which captivated the audience and caused them to give an encore. Talks were made by President Stanley, Superintendent Colville, Professor Buck and Professor Naylor. Several resolutions pertaining to the normal were presented and discussed and afterwards adopted. The teachers had selected a committee on legislation and this committee presented a set of resolutions to the normal which were adopted on a vote. The session of the normal which has just closed is one of the most successful in the history of the normal institutes in this county. The enrollment reached 131, which is less than on other years, but in the quality of work done, the instructors claim that it has been exceedingly satisfactory. One of the noticeable features about the normal has been the enthusiasm which the teachers have had over their work. Instead of neglecting their work, much study has been done and this has been a matter of comment among those interested in normal proceedings.
