Good Week's Showing for Hogs—Cattle Steady.

Yesterday most of the western live stock centers sent out reports on their big trading of either a split or a 10 to 15 cents lower, or else a flat but some lower.

Chicago and Kansas City were very weak, and St. Louis alone showed a quotation in line with Wichita.

The Wichita market was generally given out as 5 cents lower than Monday's best. This means that on Friday, while the market was 5 cents lower, there were corresponding sales made which were very much stronger than the sales on the other markets.

Yesterday there was only the usual light Saturday supply of hogs, especially light, being only a few hundred head.

There were two cars of extra prime fat hogs in which brought prices well above the market. These were special contract stuff, arranged for the hogs were selling at higher prices than the market.

The regular sales and those that were made on the open market were about 20 to 25 percent lower than the market.

The market was steady yesterday, with only a light decline and this entirely in receipts. There was no change in the market for hogs.

Yesterday afternoon there were four double loads of heavy fat hogs shipped out from the market.
