Nearly 17,000 persons have come to El Reno in the last two weeks and have been registered for the drawing which is to begin Monday.

The fact that nearly 17,000 persons have come from all over the west to register for 12,000 claims has excited some wonderment.

There is something of sentiment in this connection. The fact that the Kiowa-Omanche country is the last of the public domain to be opened to public settlement has excited something more than common interest.

The first thing in the west to become extinct was the buffalo; next came the Indian; now it is the public domain.
