NEWS FROM ALL THE RAILROADS

Ten Cars of Freight Train Are Ditched.

ON MISSOURI PACIFIC

Items of Interest About Different Employes.

Train No. 83, Missouri Pacific, local freight west bound was wrecked yesterday morning at 8:35 between Toronto and Batesville. About ten cars were ditched and traffic was delayed on account of the damage to the track. No one was injured.

It was necessary for the passenger trains to transfer their mail and passengers as the track was not made ready for use until last night about eight o'clock. The cause of the wreck is not known, but it is believed to be the result of a portion of the brakes on one of the cars breaking and falling to the track.

NEW RULE MADE.

Santa Fe Will Suspend All Garnisheed Employes.

H. U. Mudge, general manager of the Santa Fe, has issued a circular in which he states that hereafter when any employe of the Santa Fe is garnisheed he will be suspended from the service until the matter is settled satisfactorily and the garnishments are withdrawn. The company has taken this action because in recent court decisions in several states the company has been held liable for double payment.

Under the old rule the employes were not suspended and no action was taken until the third garnishment, then they were permanently discharged. The officials think that the new rule will tend to decrease the number of garnishments. The new circular reads as follows:

Topeka, Kan., March 1, 1904.

All Concerned:

Circulars No. 33, issued June 12, 1891; No. 1, January 15, 1898, and No. 16, January 26, 1897, with reference to garnishments, are hereby cancelled.

On and after this date any employe who is garnisheed will be suspended from service until the matter is settled and garnishments withdrawn.

It is found necessary to establish this rule because of different court decisions in several states under some of which the railway company is liable for double payment.

Santa Fe passenger train No. 18 which left here at 10:23 Thursday night ran through a switch at Emporia Junction early Friday morning and the engine and baggage car were derailed. The equipment remained upright and no one was injured, which was probably accounted for by the fact that the train was running at low speed. The wreck completely blocked the track for three hours and No. 8 eastbound was sent to Kansas City over the cut-off. The track was cleared up yesterday and trains were running as usual.
