Foreign News Items. LONDON, November 26th.—Lord Coleridge, Chief Justice of the Common Pleas, has been appointed Chief Justice of the Queen's Bench, vice Sir Alexander Cockburn, deceased.

VIENNA, November 26th.—The Montenegrins passed through Mazzara, leaving a garrison there, and occupied the Turkish intrenchments on the heights. A detachment subsequently advanced to take possession of Dulcigno.

CONSTANTINOPLE, November 26th.—In the fighting which preceded the occupation of Dulcigno by Derwish Pasha, the Turks lost 200 killed and wounded and the Albanians 400.

VIENNA, November 26th.—Official information is received that Derwish Pasha personally surrendered Dulcigno to the Montenegrins.
